



Award Nomination: Assessor of the Year

This award honors an individual who demonstrates extraordinary support in furthering the Commission's goals of assessing agencies fairly and effectively.

Minimum qualifications:

Member of a law enforcement agency, correctional facility, inspectors general office, or a pretrial or probation services agency that has been in the state accreditation process for a minimum of one year; has successfully conducted at least one formal assessment as assigned by the Florida Accreditation Office during the calendar year for which they are being nominated.

Nominations can be submitted by CEO, member's supervisor, assessors, members from the agency being assessed, Commissioners, or Commission staff.
